



### **Guidelines**

Design	<ul> <li>The text "Presented by" must be included.         Example: Presented By         <ul> <li>For Sponsored Editorial Modules created internally, a large high-definition logo/creative asset must be provided as a layered .eps, .psd, or .ai file of 5MB or less.</li> <li>A single file with the creative content for logo placement may be submitted, as the sizes are consistent across all screen sizes. Please note that logo placement may vary depending on screen size and page layout.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Animation / Ad Behavior Guidelines	Animations are not allowed in this unit. Only static images are accepted.
Delivery Limits	• There are no delivery limits.
Third Party Tags	The Sponsored Editorial Module must be served internally; it cannot be served by an external vendor.
Delivery Deadline	Testing and approval require 5 business days.
Video	Videos are not allowed in this unit.
HTTPS Compatibility	<ul> <li>All creative content, including third-party tags and third-party tracking tags, must use a secure protocol (HTTPS).</li> <li>Any creative content that is not secure will be returned for revision.</li> </ul>
